## Funeral Mass Planning Sheet

*A Guide for Family Participation*

We have provided this "Funeral Planning Sheet - A Guide for Family Participation" in order to assist bereaved family members in the preparation of the funeral Mass. **Arrival at the Church:** As the funeral begins, the funeral pall is placed upon the casket as a reminder of the baptismal garment. Family members are asked to assist in placing the funeral pall on the casket.

**Scripture Readings:** Family members may select scripture readings from below, and also come forward to proclaim the reading during the funeral Mass. Only one readings is necessary and may be taken from either the Old Testament or the New Testament. If two readings are to be used, then please choose one of each. *Scriptural readings at Mass may only be taken from the Catholic Lectionary and may not be altered in any way. Readings from any other versions of the Bible are not permitted by liturgical law. Only one reader is permitted for each reading. A single reading may not be divided up into parts among readers.*
